

When is the Right Time for Hospice Care?



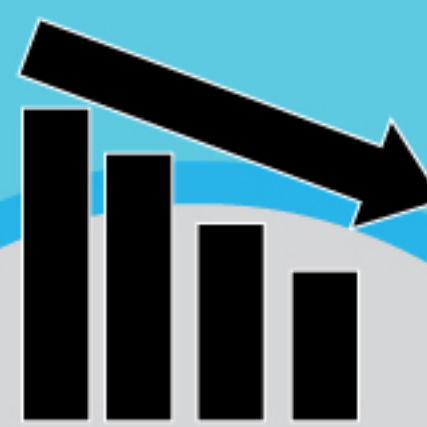
There is progressive loss of function - walking, bathing, toileting, eating.
